This are to Certify that Thos. Snead formely a Soldier in the 16th Virginia Redgment has duly and Faithfully served his time of three yeares for which He was Inlisted in Concequence of which and at his Owne Request Is heareby Discharged from any other Service in the army of the United States and permitted To return to his home free and Unmolisted he Haveing receieved all his Bounty pay and Clothing & Deficientys of pay and Clothing in full of all allowance And provision and made by the Congress for the Troopes his receipt for which is on the back hearof

Given under my hand at Philadelphia this day of Febry 1780 Christian Febiger [VAS675]
