I do Certify that William Spender inlisted as a Soldier in the third Virginia Regiment in August 1777 under Captain Gustavus B. Wallace, for three years and served his time faithfully. He has drawn his pay and depreciation on pay up to the expiration of his Enlistment, and only claims bounty of Land.
