I Certify it appears from a list of the names of the soldiers of the Va. line on Continental establishment who received Certificates for the balance of their full pay agreeably to an act of assembly passed the November Session 1781, that a certificate issued on the 26th day of March 1783 in the name of James Stackpole soldier in the infantry for the sum of £103.11.7. given under my hand this 13 Feb. 1818.
