


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

State of Tennessee Roane County} I hereby certify that John Taylor Inlisted as Serjant in Colo.
August 24th 1811 } George Bailor [sic: George Baylor W5966] Regiment of Light
Dragoon for three years and dide [sic: died] as I understood belong to Capt'n Cadwaler Jones [sic:
Cadwallader Jones BLWt2308] Company or Troop and that he Died In the Service and that his Heirs
never Recved any pay or Bounty Land for his service. Given under my hand the Date above
Sam'l Walker [Samuel Walker S39117] Leat
Lieut in Colo Gest Regmt [Nathaniel Gist BLWt1874-500]



The barer of this Paper Cawfield Taylor [VAS4660] is all the Surviving Brother to the above John Taylor
Dec'd.

Given under my hand the 2nd Day of Sept'r 1811 Sam'l Walker as above

This is to certify to all whom it may Concern that in the Month of Aug't 1777 John Taylor inlisted
as a Serjeant in Captain Cadwaller Jones Troop of Light Dragoons It being the 4th Troop of the 3^d Reg't
Commanded by Colo. George Bailor & s'd Taylor died in the month April the 25 day in the year 1778. I
further state that from the time of his Inlistment to the time he died I belonged to the same Troop. Given
under my and this [blank] day of Sep'r 1811. John Walker [S48765]

And I do further Certify that s'd Taylor never rec'd any pay before he died nor his havis[?] any Land & I
belonged to the same troop & had a perfect knowledge of the whole matter concerning him from the time
he entered the service until his death John Walker
