



Thomas Taylor a soldier enlisted to serve during the present War in the Western Department [several illegible words]



I De[?] that Thomas Taylor may [undeciphered] leave [to] Pass through the County of Montgomery and Botetot [sic: Montgomery and Botetourt] after his Business without being m[?]ed but not to leave the County of Botetot until called for and then to start immediately to his Respected Corps Colo. Clarke's [sic: George Rogers Clark VAS269] Regiment at the Illinois or Elsewhere.
