

Norfolk Virginia August 19<sup>th</sup> 1811.

I William Hoffer [S38047] who was a Captain in the first Virginia State Regiment under Colo George Gibson [BLWt1985-500] during the Revolutionary War, do certify that Robert Trelaball late of the County of Norfolk was Lieutenant in the fifteenth Virginia Regiment on Continental Establishment, and that he serve at least three years.
