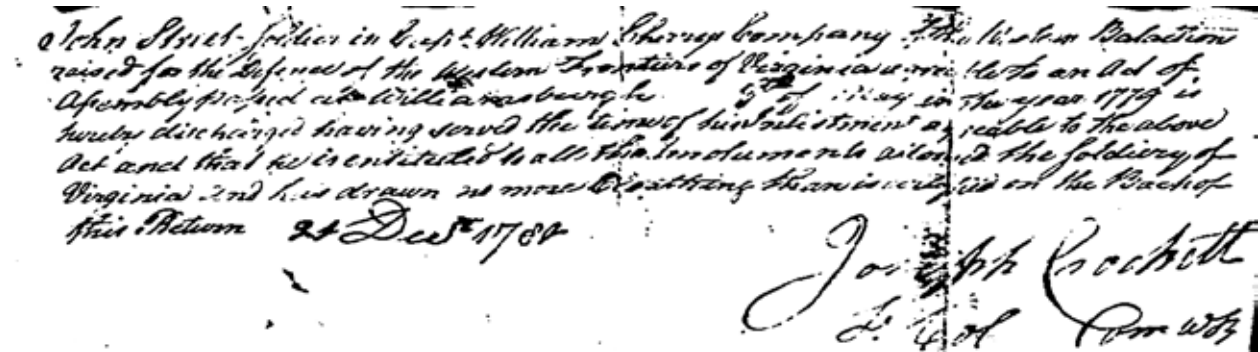

John Street Soldier in Captain William Cherrys Company of the Western Battalion raised for the Defense of the Western Frontiers of Virginia agreeable to an Act of Assembly passed at Williamsburg 3rd of May in the year 1779 is hereby discharged having served the time of his Enlistment agreeable to the above Act and that he is entitled to all the emoluments allowed the Soldiery of Virginia and has drawn no more clothing than is certified on the Back of this Returned  
21st December 1780
