The bearer Geo. Thompson formerly a Soldier in Colo. Graysons [William Grayson BLWt1366-500]  
Reg't. informs me he has lost his discharge.

I do Certify that the s'd Tompson served as a Soldier in s'd Reg't for the term of three years, &  
was discharged by Colo. Febiger [Christian Febiger VAS675] in March 1780 Given under my hand this  
27 day Oct. 1784 Thos. Bell [Thomas Bell VAS2473] Capt. Colo  
Oct'r 28<sup>th</sup> 1784 Gists [Nathaniel Gist BLWt1874-500] Reg't  
pass'd S. Hawes [Samuel Hawes BLWt1066-450] Com'r.
