Richmond Count Sct [1 April 1831]

The affidavit of Richard Woollard of Richmond county & state of Virginia age sixty five years taken before me A G Plummer a justice of the peace for said county; This affiant saith that he was acquainted with John Tillery of Richmond county & state aforesaid, and that said Tillery inlisted in the revolutionary war in the united states service for three years, this affiant farther saith that at the end of the three years he enlisted during the war, farther this affiant saith not this 1st day of April 1831
