
Virginia documents pertaining to Christopher Tompkins VAS4740

I do hereby Certify that Cristopher Tompkins of the Virginia line Served as Ensign in the 5<sup>th</sup> Regiment,  
and that he died in the s'd service. Given under my hand this 5<sup>th</sup> day of October 1783.
