Archer Toney inlisted 10<sup>th</sup> February 1777 to serve three years in the 14<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regm't and his Time of Service must consequently expire in Feb'y 10<sup>th</sup> 1780

It appears from the Muster Rolls of Capt. John Overtons [John Overton BLWt1615-300] Company that Archer Toney was enlisted 7 Feb'y 1777 for term of three years which term he did served as far as the rolls extend, This is given him to get a Land Warrant only.
