Allison [John Allison W4112] of George Townshend's having served as a Soldier three years in the first State Regiment the Term of his Enlistment, And another Certificate from Sam'l Griffin a Justice of James City County, of the said Townshend's having made Oath before him, that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said military service were produced read & ordered to be certified & recorded
