We herby Certify that we knew William Triplet as a Captain in the Late Revolutionary War with Great Brittain he Entered into Service some time in year 1775 and Continued until the end of the Ware he Commanded in the first Virginia State Ridgement on Continental Establishment Given under our hand this 5th day of June 1810
