Henry Tuggle (Soldier) in the 6th Virginia Regem't having faithfully Serv'd three years the time of his Inlistment is hereby Discharged & Commissaries are directed to furnish him with provisions till the 26 Inst. Given at mouristown [sic: Morristown NJ] Dec'r 6th 1779




