

I do hereby certify that Joshua Tuggle has served as a Soldier in the 6th & 10th Virginia Regiment from the 1st of March 1776 to the 25th of November 79, during which time he acted as a brave faithful & intrepid soldier; and the said Tuggle is hereby discharged from the service.

Given under my hand at Camp Near Morris Town [Morristown NJ] this 5th day of December 79.
