I do Certify that James Turk and Robert Turk Inlisted as Soldiers (early in the month of April 1777) to Serve in the Reg't of foot Commanded by Colo. William Grayson [BLWt1366-500] for the Term of three years. And servd as faithfull Soldiers till the Spring of 1778 when they Both died.

Given under my hand this 28th day of April 1783.
