I Do assign the pay & land I am entitled to on part to my brother George Turner to Richard Burnett for value Received of him as witness my hand this 31st Day of march 1787

William Turner came Before me a Justice of the peace for the said County & acknowledged the above assignment to Richard Burnett Given under my hand this 1st Day of April 1787

I Do Certify that George Turner Enlised as a Soldier in Capt Fleming [John Fleming] Company in the 1st Virginia Ridgment in August 1776 for three years that he served his time faithfully Given under my hand this 10th of April 1787
