This may Certifie that Thomas Turner Soldier in the 1st Virginia Reg't my Brigade has truly & faithfully Served the term for which he was engaged for agreeable to his Certificate of his enlistment, he ever behaving himself as a good Soldier and has discharged his duty to his Country in a Soldier like manner. Given under my hand this fourth day of May 1780
Charlestown [Charleston SC]. Wm Woodford Brig. Gen'l [William Woodford]
Passd, Chas. Jones Com. [Charles Jones]

I do certifie that Thos Turner enlisted the 4th day of May 1777 to serve three years which time he served faithfully, Given under my hand this 21st day of October 1784
