The bearer Mr. James Vaughan to the best of recollection inlisted with Capt Sam'l Simpson [Samuel Simpson VAS4455] the 21 Aug 1777 as a sergeant to serve in Colo. Marshalls [Thomas Marshall VAS494] Reg't of State artillery three years, during which time he serv'd as Sergeant, Sergeant Major & the later part of the time as an assistant to the Commissary. though never was discharg'd from the Reg't. Mr. Vaughan during the time of his servitude behav'd as a good and faithfull soldier
