This may Certify that Spencer Walden enlisted in 1<sup>st</sup> Virg'a State Reg't. in Jan'y or Feb. 1777 for three years, and continued in service till he died, but do not recollect the time of [his] death.  
Wyatt Coleman [VAS3066] late Lt. [illegible]

Entitled to depreciation from 1<sup>st</sup> Feby 77 to 1<sup>st</sup> Jan'y 78 if not settled/ Tho. Meriwether

It being for Value Rec'd I do Assign my right & title of the pay due Spen'r Walden from the Country & Land to Jer. Munday, which pay are Justly due him & has never been Setled & my right I do warr't.  
Aug't the 27, 1787. Jno. Walden

Test Jno. Collier

I do Assign the ball. of pay & bounty in Land due for the service of Spencer Walden dec'd as afor[esaid] to Wm Reynolds. Jer. Munday
