

Agreeable to a Resolution of Congress, bearing Date the 26th Day of May, 1783, the Bearer hereof
William Waller a soldier (War) of the first Virginia regiment has leave of Absence until called upon by
proper authority to join his Corps, or is finally discharged. Given at Charles Town this 2^d day of July
1783. Sam Finley Major Com't [Samuel Finley W10026]
