I Certify that I was well acquainted with James Ward who was a private in Capt. Grays [James Gray] Company, as well as I recollect, he was of the 15th regiment Continental line and he got killed at the battle of Germantown [4 Oct 1777] he was my file leader and I saw him fall at Witness my hand and seal this 30th day of November in the year 1832
