May 21st 1776 Kemps Land-g [Kemps Landing]

Mr. Robt. Ward has serv'd in the Comp'y of Minnett [Minuteman] Battalion till Discharge & since has serv'd with the Regular Troops at this place During which time from Nov'r last untill now I have bin Eye witness to his Conduct I can with great justness say he is Truly Deserving. he has done his Duty like a Soilder & [several illegible words] as a Vollenteer.

This is to [illegible] that Mr. [illegible] Ward has [illegible] the Virginia forces as a soldier since the first of January, and that he has conducted himself as an [illegible] and willing soldier, hazarded his life on several occasions attempting with uncommon [illegible], and born every [undeciphered] the enemy, and sending them to their shipping.
