

I do Certify that Samuel Ware Inlisted as a Soldier under the Command of Capt Richeson [Holt Richeson VAS1954] in January Seventeen hundred and seventy six in the Continentall Service in the last Revolutionary Ware in the Seventh Virginia Reg't and continued in the said Service three years and was discharged as a Serg't.

Thomas Lipscomg Ens[i]gn [VAS3952]
to the said Reg't.
