Northampton County Virginia }  
October 25<sup>th</sup> 1839[?] } The Deposition of Rachael Costen aged [illegible] years deposeth  
& saith, That Joseph Warren enlisted as a soldier from this county during the Revolutionary war in the 9<sup>th</sup>  
Virginia Regiment, and after serving three years; somewhere to the north, returned to this county. Further  
this deponent saith not.

Northampton County Virginia }  
October 25<sup>th</sup> 183[?] }  
The deposition of Southey Spady deposeth & saith that Joseph Warren enlisted as a soldier from  
this county during the Revolutionary war & after serving the time for which he enlisted returned to this  
county again & further the deponent saith not.
