I Robert Russell [W5753] of the County of Accomac [sic: Accomack] aged seventy Two years well knew Spencer Waters in the ninth virginia Regiment during the revolutionary war. I was amongst the first That enlisted and Enlisted for a tower of Three years and Servd untill I was regurally dischargd and I Further say that Spencer Waters Served for a Tower of Three years but cannot say how much longer and he was regurally discharged given under my hand this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1831.

I James Thornton [S41253] of the County of accomac aged upwards of Seventy six years well knew Spencer Warters in the ninth Virginia Regiment dureing the revolutionary war. I was amongst The first that enlisted and enlisted for a Tower of Five years, and served untill I was regularly discharged and this deponent Further says that Spencer Warters served for a Tower of Three years and he was regularly discharged given under my hand this 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1831.
