


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

August 15th 1781[?] I Do hereby Certify [several undeciphered words] Aaron [illegible] enlisted a soldier in Capt. George Lambert's [S8810] Company for three years, and served out his time faithfully in the 14 virginia regiment

Given under my hand Andrew Rodgers [S35635] Lieut.
in the 16th virginia Rigiment
A Buford Colo [Abraham Buford S46372]

A handwritten signature in cursive script, appearing to read "Andrew Rodgers". The signature is written in dark ink on a light-colored background, possibly a document or parchment. The handwriting is somewhat stylized and difficult to decipher.

At a Court held for Mercer County at Harrodsburg on the twenty fourth day of July 1789
