William Watts a Soldier in the Second Virginia State Reg't having serv'd three years from the first day of January 1777 To the first day of January 1780 is hereby dismissed the service. Given under my hand at Tawney Town [probably Taneytown MD] this 1st [illegible] John Lee Major [VAS867]

The within mentioned Soldier is to draw Provision from any Issuing Commasary from the first day of January 1780 to the 18th of this instant. John Lee Major
