





Claim to any part thereof Given from under my hand this 31st Day Dec [illegible]

I do Certify that Joseph Webb was taken in The service in the place of Thos. Ball [Thomas Ball], who
entered the 29th June 1777 for the term of three years, the said (Webb) was an able hand & served out his

For Value rec'd I do assign to Wm Reynolds the full ball[ance of] pay & bounty land due Joseph Webb as
an able Seaman for three years service to 29 June 1780 John Slaughter
