


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

This certifies that John West, a Soldier enlisted by Lieut James Slaughter [S31370] to serve at the falls of the Ohio river [now Louisville KY] for two years to expire the 25th day of last October, having served during the said term (as appears by a Certificate of the said Slaughter) is hereby discharged from the Army under the obligation of the aforesaid enlistment. given under my hand in the War office at Richmond this 3^d day of November 1781.
