Isaac Weston Late a Matross in my Reg't of artill'y having serv'd the Term of time for which he stood Obliged for is hereby Discharg'd the Service of the United States, his Conduct as a Soldier fully entitles him to the respect and Esteem of all his Country Men) Given under my hand at Williamsburg This 26th day of Sep'r 1780
