Cecil County } before the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace in and for said County John
Bennett [VAS579] of New Castle County State of Delaware late a Private in Lt
Colo Henry Lee's Legion, who being Duly sworn according to Law Deposeth and saith that he was well
acquainted with James White, and about the year 1778 he inlisted in Lt Colo Henry Lees Legion in the
services of the united states, and in which he continued in said Legion in the third troop until he was kil'd
in South Carolina about the Close of the Revolutionary war.

1778 he inlisted in Lt Colo Henry Lee's Legion and Belonged to the third Troop Commanded by Capt
Egleston [Joseph Eggleston W8687] in said Legion, and about the Close of the Revolutionary war he was
kil'd in South Carolina.
