To the Honorable David Campbell Governor of Virginia

Your Petitioners Armistead Manning [blank space] heirs of John White a Lieutenant in the Virginia Continental Line in the war of the Revolution Respectfully Represents to your honer that they are Entitled to adishional Land Bounty, that Land Bounty was only allowed Leut. White for a survice of three years when he was Entitled for the War your Petitoers would beg Leave to refer your houner to the proof heareto fore filed and the Late Commissioners Report on this Clame, that the said John White Entered in 1776 or 1777 as your Petitioners are informed and verily believe that he surved till his death, your Pititioners would prey a reconsideration as in duly bound &c &c
test/ Zelaten Gargle[?] Armistead X Manning heirs and only heirs of John White Leut C. Line
