


Point of Fork 1 May 1783

The bearer Richard White a Soldier in the State Legion who has acted as an Artificer at this post (being engaged for the War) has served the Term for which he was enlisted for; he therefore is discharged from the Service of the S. Legion per Order of the Governor of the s'd State; Given under my hand this first day of May 1783.
