I do certify that Capt. Robert White was appointed and Officer in the Virginia line the ninth day of December 1776, and was invalided the 8th of September 1781. Given under my hand this 12th Feb'y 1783

NOTE: According to E. M. Sanchez-Saavedra (*A Guide to Virginia Military Organizations in the American Revolution* p 121), Capt. Robert White had been in the 8th Virginia Continental Regiment, which had been sent to the Carolinas. The date on which White was invalided was the date of the battle of Eutaw Springs in South Carolina.
