The bearer hereof Levy Whitetors a Soldier of the 1st Virginia Regiment haveing Served Three years in the service of the United States being the full Term for wich he Inlisted is hereby Discharged the Service Given under my hand at Philadelphis This 30th day of December 17[??]

The Above Mentioned Levy Whitetors is intited to draw rations on his way to Princesann [sic: Princess Anne] County in Virginia.
