I do hereby certify that Beverly Whiting entred the Service as a Ensign in the Virginia line on  
Contenentale establishment, April one thousand Seven hundred and seventy six and contuned therein  
upwards of three years; and never was sespended or disgressed [disgraced?] as fare as I no or beleve  
Given under my hand this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1806. Tarpley White [R18959]  
Late Capt of the 5<sup>th</sup> Virginia Reg't.

I well recollect to have seen Beverly Whiting in the month of January or Febr. 1781 as a subaltern of the  
U. S. Army, but do not know when he entred the service, or when he quit the service.  
Given under my hand this 22<sup>d</sup> day sept'r. 1806. Simon Morgan [W8475]
