I Do Certify that Dan'l Whitten Sold'r of my Company did Enlist on the 28th of July 1781 to serve for
During the present War – but he being summoned from this Worldly Situation on the 24th September 1783
his Heirs, Executors in Adm'n [administration of his estate] are justly entitled to receive the Pay and
Emoluments due unto the s'd Daniel Whitten for his service.
