James Wilder a seaman belonging to the ship Dragon having served three years in the service the time of his Enlistment, is hereby Discharged from the service, given from under my hand this 1st day of March 1780

Sir Please to Grant a Certifycate for what Land I may be Intitled to unto Mr Joseph Sanders and this my Note Shall Be your Discharge.
