I do hereby Certify that Jesse Winder Inlisted in My Company when I was a Captain, in the month Of
Febuary 1776 to serve two years that he reinlisted In November 1777 when he was made a Sergeant
Which time expired whilst he was on duty in the Southern Army but he did not demand it as he was then a
prisoner from the fall of Charles Town [Charleston, 12 May 1780] Jesse Winder Returned with the
prisoners in the Month of July 1781 till which time he Expects to Recive his pay & Depreciation & Ive no
doubt will be allowed it
