I DO with the advice of the Council hereby certify, that Sarah Wilkerson widow of Thomas Wilkerson who was a private in the 15th Virginia Regim't and died in the service of The United States is entitled to the sum of Six pounds yearly; which allowance is to commence from the first day of January 1786.

GIVEN under my hand as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, at Richmond this 12th day of November 1787.

Sussex County to Wit May Court 1790

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County pay Sarah Wilkerson a pensioner the Sum of Six pounds for her pension for the year 1789.
