


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

I do certify that James Wilkins was a Soldier of my Company of Artillery & was taken prisoner the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Aug't 1780 [Battle of Camden SC] & I was informed that he died in Jail in Charleston the said soldier was enlisted some time in Dec'r 1777 or January 1778

Ch'r Roane [Christopher Roane X635] late Capt  
Pass'd for service from Jan 78 to Aug't 80. T. Meriwether Com[missione]r  
the above mention'd soldier was enlisted for the war. May 27 85

Marshall's [Thomas Marshall VAS494] regiment of Artillery which I warrant to be good and yet valid. Given 2<sup>d</sup> au't 1784 [signed] Robert Wilkins
