These are to Certify that the barer hereof James Harris Soldier in the Virginia Cavalry Regiment haveing faithfully served the United States three years and being Inlisted for the war, Is hereby discharged from the American Army

Given at the war office John Perry Capt By order of the Secretary at war B Lincoln {Benjamin Lincoln]

To Mr. Thos. Meriwether

Sir please to Issue a Land Warrant for the within Discharge to Henry Pendleton and you'l Oblige
