



This is to Certify Francis Williams Listed January the 17th 1777 And I do Certify from The Day of His enlistment he is to Serve as a Soldier Two years at the Barracks in albemarle County And If he is Carried out of That County to armands [Legion of Charles Armand BLWt2291-850] During the [undeciphered] as a Dragoon and farther from the day of his [undeciphered] he is to Serve two years [undeciphered] which time he is to Be Discharged from The Barracks
