

I do hereby Certify that John Williams Served three years as a private Soldier in Coll'o John Gibson's [S41578] Regiment in the Virginia Continental line at pittsburgh given under my hand this 8th day of April 1812
John Mills [W5378] late an
Ensign in said Reg't
