I do certify that John Williams a soldier in Colo Charles Harrison's [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Regiment of Artillery was enlisted in the year one thousand seven hundred & seventy seven for three years, & in the Spring one thousand seven hundred & seventy nine he Reenlisted under Capt Fleming Gaines [William Fleming Gaines BLWt880-300] for the war. Given under my hand this 6 day [illegible] 1783
