This day John Williams inlisted with me to serve as a Soldier in one of the nine continental Regiments raised in this State during the present war in the Room of Thomas Colson & Richardson Hensley two of the militia of said County agreeable to an act of the General Assembly at Wm'sburg the 5th may last

given under my hand this the 11th day of July 1777.
