This is to Certifie that Moses Williams Inlisted with me the 6 day of Jam'y one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven to serve in the Navy the term of three years which term he served and discharged his duty true and faithfully and is hereby Discharged Given under my hand this 6 Day of January 1780
