At a Court held for James City County June the 12th 1780 A Certificate from Colo. William Brent [VAS2639] of William Williams's having served three years as a Soldier in the Second State Regiment the Term of his Enlistment, And another Certificate from James McClung a Justice of York County, of the said Williams's having made Oath before him, that he never before proved or claimed his Right to Land for his said Military Service, were produced & read & ordered to be certified & recorded
