I Lewis Stoakes [Lewis Stokes S6158] of Gloucester County Doth Certify that I am now in my seventyeth year of age. I was in service in the revolutionary war in a Militia Company Commanded by Gibson Clevius [Gibson Cluverius W8061]. I knew William Williams who was on board of the Henry Galley at one time and after serveing his tower out, he enlisted in the Virginia Continental Line and went away he remained in service for dureing the War, how long he was on board the galley I cannot say. he was from the aforesaid County. I was borne and raised in the same County as Witness my hand and seal this first day of May in the year 1833
